

Reflex Competitions Team Name Ideas



With Reflex Competitions, students in one classroom can now face off against other classes in a school for amped-up engagement, fun rivalry, and increased math fact fluency motivation!

Teachers: When setting up a new competition, you will be prompted to select a “Team” (Reflex class group) to participate. You will then enter a custom team name for your group of students. You can also customize your team with an icon and team color.

Every team needs a winning name! Looking for some inspiration? Try these ideas to stir up classroom creativity and student engagement.

Incorporate Reflex characters and games

If your students are familiar with Reflex, combine their favorite characters or games with math terms for catchy team names.

- Examples:
- Crabby’s Calculators
 - Number Ninjas
 - Coach Penny’s Champs
 - Alien Sundae Stars
 - Green Light Go-Getters
 - Fact Fair Frenzies
 - Wind Rider Warriors
 - Hamster Racers

Emphasize community

Build a sense of comradery with a team name all students can relate to. Incorporate your school name, school mascot, city/town name, or local landmarks to create a team name all students identify with.

Encourage student submissions

Boost excitement for math fact fluency and get students involved with team name brainstorming. Consider accepting ongoing student submissions, or host weekly class brainstorming sessions during math time. Students can vote on team names and reflect on progress from previous Reflex Competitions.
